

## Notes from the Game on Tournament organiser 18/07/21

“We’ve worked closely with the facility provider (USW Sport Park) in order to deliver this event in a safe way – a reminder of the key principles:

- We need to carefully manage the amount of participants and avoid crossover between age groups / teams. Therefore, we encourage all teams to keep to a particular area i.e. the outdoor stand. Social distancing must be maintained when not playing and face coverings worn when entering the main building to access toilets, vending machines etc.
- No spectators will be allowed entry and will be asked to leave.
- Nobody should be attending if they have symptoms or have been in contact with anyone who has COVID-19.
- No handshakes.
- Venue rules to be adhered to when entering and leaving. Toilet facilities can be accessed through the main reception area, the one-way system must be adhered to and any persons using the facilities must exit via the back entrance (signposted by USW).
- **There will be no changing facilities available to coaches, players or officials.**
- Parking is at the ‘bottom / first’ car park at USW Sport Park. Sat Nav: CF37 5UP
- Only the team organiser to register at our registration desk on arrival. This will be situated by the entrance to outdoor 4G (please do not go through the main USW reception).

Important: All participants, coaches, officials and staff must complete a participant form prior to taking part which will include contact / emergency contact details – this may also be used for track & trace purposes. This participant form can be completed on the day but to save time we encourage all participants to complete the form in advance of the date and the team organiser to collate and pass them to us upon registration.

Registration will be open from 1.15pm. Please do not turn up any earlier as there is a prior booking and we again need to avoid crossover.

A short introduction and (weather permitting) socially distanced group photo will take place at 1.45pm on the outdoor 4G. Action underway at 2pm. The event will finish by 6pm.

‘THE POTTERY’ pub, across the road from the Sport Park, will be open for liquid refreshments post event.
